All classes except classes 5,6 & 7 must be of British manufacture and have been readily available for sale to the general public before the eligibility date of the class. Classes concerned must be fitted with British front forks, motor/gearbox, main frame loop and hubs. Carburettor except classes 5, 6 & 7 should be of British manufacture up to Amal Mk 1. No reed valves. Replica frames will be accepted providing they are 90% identical to the original and readily available to the public. Any machine that does not comply will be entered in the special class. Trail bikes must have working lights. All classes must have trials tyres fitted. Clutch and brake levers must end with a 3/4" ball. All machines must be legal for the highway, with MOT and road tax subject to historic exemption.

Chavenage House, Tetbury, Gloucestershire GL8 8XP We will be able to park in the car park for the duration of the trial. Parking is at your own risk. Lock valuables away. Please park tidy and respectfully as other visitors will be using the car park. Signing on will be open from 8.30 am. The first riders will be started at 9.30 am. There will be no fuel at the start however, a petrol station is located approx 5 miles away at Nailsworth. Refreshments will be available to purchase at the end of the trial. Please support our hosts at the venue. There will only be toilet facilities after 10am.

The route will be approximately 50 miles around the Cotswolds and 5 valleys with 45 sections to test riders slow speed skills, balance and machine control. There will be some tarmac roads leading to unpaved green roads and private land. At all times, riders must show respect to walkers, horse riders and other highway/byway users. Any gates must be closed after passing through. Highway code conduct rules apply at all times. Failure to apply by these instructions will result in exclusion. We do not under any circumstances wish to jeopardise the permission of the landowners to use their land.

Sections will be scored using the 0-1-2-3-5 system. No stopping. Failure is deemed to have occurred when the machine ceases forward motion.
